All students received a [campus notice](#) from the Chancellor's Office on Friday, October 23rd.

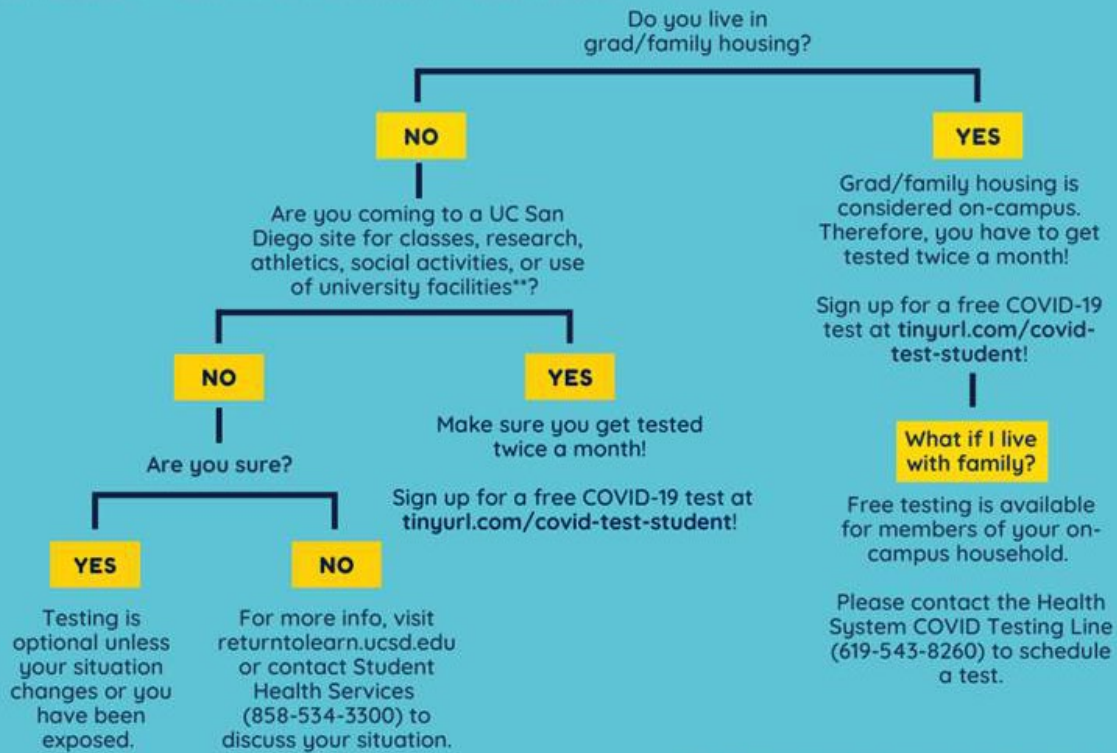
We wanted to amplify the Holiday Travel Guidelines shared in the message as well as offer additional guidance about Fall Break specifically for graduate and professional students living in UC San Diego housing.

As noted in Friday's message, all students are welcome to stay on campus over the Fall Break on Thursday and Friday, November 26 and 27. There will be activities and health services to support you during the break.

Those living in UC San Diego housing with roommates [not in your immediate family] who plan to leave campus and gather with others during Fall Break should be aware of the following requirements upon returning to campus: You will need to wear a face covering at all times (even in your apartment, except when asleep or in the shower). You also will need to be tested within 24 hours of returning, again within five days, and once more within 10 days after your return to campus. As a reminder, all students living in UC San Diego housing must get tested for COVID-19 every two weeks with each test completed at least every 12 days with no more than 16 days between tests.
